


Fig. 1. Effect of temperature on the rate of lactose hydrolysis by *K. lactis*. Lactose solution (0.1 M) was incubated at 30, 40, 50, or 60°C. The reaction was initiated by adding 0.1 ml of a culture of *K. lactis* (ATCC 6255) to 1 ml of lactose solution. The reaction mixture was maintained at the indicated temperature. The reaction was stopped by adding 1 ml of 0.1 N H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub> to each tube.

the *K. lactis* culture, the culture was centrifuged at 10,000 × g for 10 min at 20°C. The supernatant was used for the assay.

The reaction mixture contained 0.1 ml of lactose solution (0.1 M), 0.1 ml of culture supernatant, and 0.1 ml of 0.1 N H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>.

The reaction mixture was maintained at the indicated temperature for 10 min. The reaction was stopped by adding 1 ml of 0.1 N H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub> to each tube.

The reaction mixture was then assayed for lactose hydrolysis as described previously (1).

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
